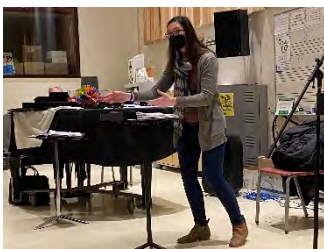
## Experience DCC
